When residents move into Robinson House Care Home, they're welcomed as part of our family.

The whole team, from our nurses and carers to our housekeepers, are passionate about getting to know you so we can provide care and support tailored to your preferences.

Robinson House is a 70-bed home situated in a quiet cul-desac in Stockwood that offers 24/7 nursing care for older people with specific nursing needs, including those living with a dementia. The home was built in 1993 and a reconfiguration of the original building was completed in 2012. The reconfiguration resulted in two floors of 35 single rooms with each floor being fully accessible

particularly for people living with dementia. Our care home has been accredited by the Gold Standards Framework for our excellent standard of end of life care. We have a personcentred approach to care which maintains your dignity and respect.

Robinson House provides an environment that is stimulating for people living with dementia. The lounges and rooms look out onto private, secure gardens with plenty of areas for residents and visiting friends and family to sit and catch up with their loved ones.

We actively seek to improve the wellbeing of the people who live with us. Our dedicated team of homemakers supports this goal by ensuring residents feel fulfilled in all areas of life, from making their living space feel like home to ensuring that varied and stimulating activities are taking place, all while offering support and guidance for families of those being cared for.



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What funding option is right for me?

How you fund your place at Robinson House will depend on your care needs and individual circumstances. There are three funding options to choose from at Robinson House Care Home:

1. Self-funded Care -

People with assets over the Government savings threshold will be eligible to fund their own care.

2. Local Authority Funded Care -

You might be eligible for the local council to pay towards the cost of your care, depending on the total amount you have in savings. Exactly how much your council will pay depends on what care you need and how much you can afford to pay.

3. Care funded by Health (Continuing Healthcare)

You may be entitled to care funded by NHS Continuing Healthcare – this is a fully-funded package of care that some people are entitled to receive as a result of disability, accident or illness. It covers the full cost of the person's care and residential accommodation.

Frequently asked questions

- Will I have my own private space with bathroom facilities?
- A Absolutely! All rooms at Robinson House feature an ensuite with a level-access wetroom shower and toilet. Residents also have access to baths equipped with hoists for ease of use.
- Can visitors come to Robinson House?
- A Certainly! Robinson House is your home, and we warmly welcome visitors, even at meal times.
- Can you bring your pet?
- A Requests will be considered on an individual basis, please contact the Care Home Manager for more information.
- Q Can you choose meal times and options?
- A Absolutely! Residents at Robinson House can select their meal times and enjoy a choice of two lunch and dinner options, including a vegetarian selection and various breakfast choices.
- Can residents decide their sleeping and waking times?
- A Yes, residents are free to choose their bedtime and waking hours based on their preferences.
- Q Are there designated smoking areas?
- A Robinson House is a nonsmoking facility, but we do provide an outdoor smoking area on site.

- How can I contact my loved ones?
- A You can bring your mobile phone or you can use our Robinson House wireless phone services to talk to loved ones. We also have a tablet where residents can video call their loved ones!
- Can I visit the care home before making a decision?
- A Certainly! We encourage prospective residents and their families to visit Robinson House. Please contact the Care Home Manager to arrange a visit or for any additional information.
- O How does the home handle complaints?
- A We have a clear procedure for addressing both complaints and compliments, which is prominently displayed within the home. More information is also available on our website:

- Q How do I pay my fees?
